Lemons Scholarship (TMLS), established through the generosity of the lighting design firm Available Light. **The goal of the TMLS is to financially assist an outstanding Junior, Senior or graduate-level student who is a US citizen and is committed to studying and practicing in the field of architectural lighting design in the United States.**

The winning scholarship recipient will be awarded \$4,000 USD per year over a maximum of two years. The second year is contingent on the student continuing his/her architectural lighting design studies, as well as remaining enrolled in a qualified program. This scholarship will assist the chosen student with expenses such as tuition, books and room & board.

The Thomas M. Lemons Scholarship will be awarded in May 2010, with the winning recipient announced at LIGHTFAIR International in Las Vegas, NV USA.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Please compile one PDF consisting of the following items:

- a. Completed Application form.
- b. Copy of Official University Transcript.
- c. Resume (2 page LIMIT).
- d. (2) Two Letters of Recommendation.
- e. Personal statement about your experience with lighting, why you want to study lighting, **or** why you should receive this scholarship. (2 page LIMIT).
- f. Up to 10 images of your work (10 image LIMIT)
 - i. Insert images (300 dpi) into a PowerPoint presentation with one image per slide.
 - ii. Descriptive text can be added to each slide but is not required.
 - iii. Save PowerPoint presentation as a PDF handout with 2 slides per page and combine into one PDF with other documents.
